CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL 645 SQUAD CLUB DONATES TO MEMORIAL FOUNDATION

On April 4, 2019 the members of the San Diego CHP, held a fundraiser for the Foundation and its work to remember all law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty within San Diego County.

On May 1, 2019, the day of annual Memorial Ceremony for remembrance for the San Diego County Law Enforcement Foundation, the San Diego 645 Squad Club of the California Highway Patrol presented a major donation to the Foundation resulting from that fund raiser.

Standing in front of the Memorial's "Wall of Light", representatives of the 645 Squad Club presented a check to Skip Murphy, President of the Foundation and retired San Diego County Sheriff's Captain. The check totaling over \$11,000 was the largest donation ever received by the Foundation since its formation in 1999.

"This donation will significantly increase our ability to complete our memorial to all those law enforcement officers who stood tall and gave their lives protecting the citizens of San Diego County", said Skip Murphy. "The commitment of the San Diego members of the California Highway Patrol in supporting this effort is absolutely fantastic and our appreciation cannot be stated with a mere thank you".

The Memorial Wall of Light is inscribed with the names of 87 law enforcement officers from all federal, state, county and city agencies within the county who died in the line of duty. Seven are from the California Highway Patrol.
